#### Four main areas of focus from 2019:

- **First quarter:** Collect all documentation for the 10-year HP research. Creation of FHCi monthly family newsletter.
- Second quarter: Provide advanced HP education for existing HP supervisors on 1. Program changes; 2. Ethical and legal issues; 3. How to give a public lecture, connect with HP supervisors in the field, facilitate participation in local presentations on HP, and encourage networking with families and communities. Publication of Practitioner Code of Ethics.
- **Third quarter:** Analysis, conclusions, and submission for publication for Long-Term Homeoprophylaxis research data.
- Fourth quarter: Hold strategic planning meeting for 2020.
   Review year end accomplishments. Open Board positions to include HP family members. Initiation of self-audit process.

## 2019 marked the completion of FHCi 10 Year Research Project: Long-Term Homeoprophylaxis study in children in North America. Part One and Part Two:

**December 2019:** Publication of Part One in Similia, Journal of the Australian Society of Homeopaths, Volume 31, Number 2: Factors contributing to the successful completion of sequential dosing of disease nosodes.

**June 2020:** Publication of Part Two in Similia, Volume 32 Number 1: Long-term Homeoprophylaxis study in children in North America Part Two: Safety of HP, review of immunological responses, and effects on general health outcomes.

#### What is Homeoprophylaxis (HP)?

HP involves using homeopathic remedies called "nosodes" to stimulate and educate the immune system toward the infectious disease process. Nosodes are made from pure disease agents only: no adjuvants, growth mediums, or preservatives.


- HP serves to engage the immune system to the environment which normalizes ones' relationship to bacteria and viruses.


