2025 ANNUAL REPORT

For 2026 we launched our NEW website and database system (FHCi.info)



2025 has been an amazing year of continued development and completion. 2025 was also a year of review: in getting ready for deploying our new secure website and database system, we undertook a self-auditing process on many levels in preparation for this launching.

Homeoprophylaxis questions the origins of disease. Healthy Biome HPx Program was new in 2022. Findings from our 2025 retrospective study indicate that when the individual and their biome is in balance, marked improvements in wellbeing and vitality are experienced. In addition, various infections disease outbreaks and topical interests led to development of 9 new programs of which 6 one-off single disease HPx Programs were developed.

The 2025 self-auditing process included the following:

- completed economic review in the face of the expense of building this new system
 - surveyed and sought to remedy FHCi Practitioner education levels to make sure they are meeting the needs of the clients they serve in their practices
 - surveyed FHCi Patron body as to who is doing HPx and who referred them. We understand that many families chose HPx in isolation of their family system because their extended families don't believe or understand.
 - surveyed results showed that Homeopaths, doctors, friends, and neighbors were referring to HPx
 - launched major social media campaigns to bring more education into the public
 - hired two new people to work in the administrative team to tighten up the communication platform; and ensure a tight rein on the inner workings of FHCi
 - reviewed board members commitments to the work, continuation of collaboration in this common mission
- All of these exercises have served to shore up the fiscal and social responsibility FHCi holds towards our practitioners and patrons as we move into 2026.

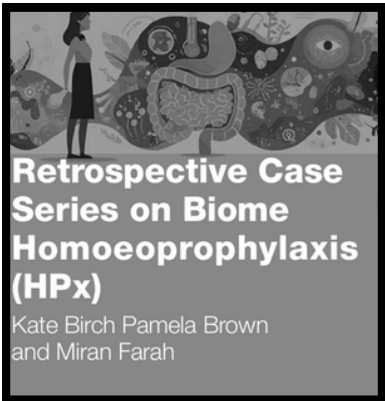
HEALTHY BIOME HPX RETROSPECTIVE STUDY

Originally published in Similia 2025, Volume 38 no. 2, p34-42.
FHCi conducted a retrospective study in 2025 on participants experience of the novel Healthy Biome HPX program. The results were published in the Similimum in December of 2025.

“The findings indicated when the individual and their biome is in balance, marked improvements in wellbeing and vitality are experienced. Suggesting that the sequential dosing of nosodes related to the microbiome has advantageous effects.

“HPx, as it relates to this program, broadens the definition to include the concept of “energetic inoculation” and “biotic displacement.”

Correspondingly, the results of collective biotic harmony can only lead to greater cohesion within our families and communities. This is the vision FHCi holds for this HPx Program.

In addition to FHCi's quarterly HPx Certification Sessions, the following new courses were added to the curriculum.

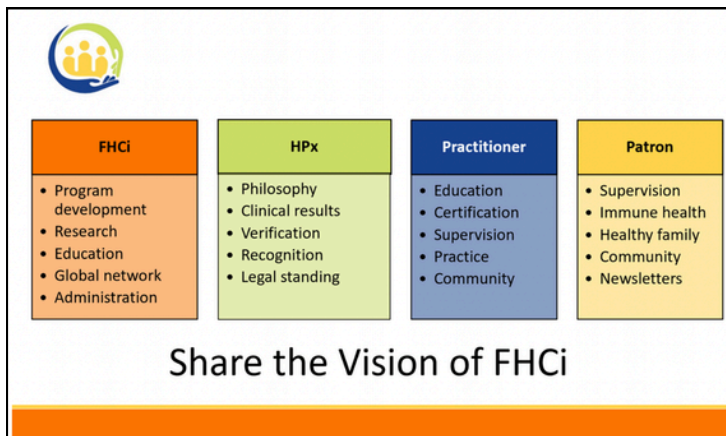
Live Courses New in 2025:

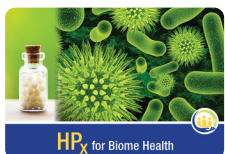
