Achievements for 2014

FHCi has been working tirelessly since 2011 on the work of promoting Homeoprophylaxis through educating supervisors, writing research, tracking data, and establishing FHCi as a 501(c)3 Public Charity. In September 2014 we were granted IRS charity status dating back to February 2013 when we established ourselves as a MN non-profit.

- To date all of the work on the board has been voluntary.
- Most of our travel has been paid for independently.
- To date we have 90 educated and certified HP supervisors in Canada, the United States, Japan and various countries in the EU.
- We are providing parents an alternative to vaccination.
- We do this work because we believe in it.

Over the summer of 2014 board changes included the departure r resignations of Cilla Whatcott - co-founder and Cathy Lemmon - International development and a temporary leave of absence of Sarah Hutchinson - International liaison to Canada. The loss of these board members stalled some of our direction and impetus. However, with the New Year, and two new board members we have regrouped and set our course for the future.

At the end of 2014 we closed the entrance to research for new families. We are still gathering papers and tabulating records but estimate that we have over 600 children entered in research: We will follow these families through the duration of the program..

In 2014 we stepped out into the world to introduce ourselves and further the work of expanding exposure to Homeoprophylaxis and education on infectious disease. Our work has been met with enthusiasm and interest around the world. Through attending, presenting or teaching at these conferences we have had the opportunity to gain understanding on access to homeopathy and homeoprophylaxis internationally and to assess the political and social climate of concern regarding the vaccine paradigm.
